



**Minutes from AYC KHF Handicap Committee Open Meeting  
May 08, 2007**

1. Call to order at 7:40 PM.
2. We looked at 1 new PHRF application for the Corsair 750 Trimaran giving a provisional rating of 15 which is subject to review anytime during the first two quarters of racing. Since this is a new boat to Lake Travis, we looked at information provided by the owner there is no other Handicap information published on this boat.
3. We Converted 1 Immediate ratings given at past regattas to official ratings and renewed 1 rating without changes. ( see Table, next page)
4. The committee reviewed an application for a rating an Wasabi, an 11 Metre boat with a larger than class specification mainsail. And a Genoa with Lp of 140%  
We reviewed the boat's original rating request form and the appeals that were filed to arrive at the rating of 72. The prior rating of 72 was with larger jib and seems appropriate given the performance of Wasabi in PHRF.

The new mainsail does not conform exactly to the one design rules and is slightly larger near the head and slightly smaller at the foot based on the measurements. The overall sail appears to be slightly larger by at least 1 %

We reviewed the rating of the other 11 metre in the club and its configuration to understand the differences.

The 11 metre one design rules specify the use of the IMS measurement rules when making sail measurements. The headboard measurement in IMS is luff to leach versus width of the headboard itself in other classes.

Based on all that the committee agreed on a PHRF of 69, a difference of -3 sec per mile for Wasabi with the new sail. (3 seconds a mile is the minimum adjustment we make).

5. The committee discussed changes in the rating request form for 2008 and agreed on the following:
  - a) We will eliminate the question on fully battened mainsail
  - b) We will add the following question: “Does your boat conform to the stock (IE One Design Rule, if such rules exist) configuration boat and sails?”
6. The next meeting will be a working session on June 12
7. The Handicappers for the Turnback regatta on May 26 will be Ray Shull and John Maddalozzo.
8. The meeting was adjourned at 8:55
