## **We are turning docks 4, 5 and 6 to normal orientation.**

On July 25<sup>th</sup> 2009 at 638.2 MSL we turned docks 4, 5 and 6 parallel to the shore to accommodate our shrinking harbor. The the lake back up above 642 MSL and more rain forecast, we will be turning the docks back to normal orientation. The primary reason for this change is that our dock system can better accommodate a sudden lake rise when configured in the normal orientation.
