Objectives and Key Assumptions

1. Avoid the Cutting Edge

The AYC Board makes decisions based upon available information and is prudent in the timing of executing changes. This means that AYC's actions may be delayed in comparison to other establishments.

2. Keep exposure risk down

Reduce the opportunity for exposure by reducing the number of people at the club at any point in time and limit activities which require people to be confined in a limited space at any point in time.

3. Equal Opportunity to Enjoy the Club

Given that all members follow the AYC COVID guidelines, high and low risk persons should be able to enjoy the club. However, it is the responsibility of each person to decide which activities fall within their tolerance of risk and engage in club activities accordingly.

4. Continuous Improvement

Identify opportunities where increasing availability may be performed based upon the guidelines identified below.

5. Unknowns

Examples – Exact transmission methods are not known. How exposure to the virus affects individuals is not known.

6. All Members will follow the Good Neighbor Policy

All individuals will comply with the guidelines to reduce the opportunity of exposure for our low and high risk members and guests. The AYC membership self-manages.

- 7. AYC follows the CDC Guidelines for Disinfection & Sanitizing Key areas identified – High Contact Areas, Cabins, Bathrooms, Sail Training and RC Boats, Cabins, Common Areas, Porta Potty
- 8. All Decisions are Subject to Change

As unknowns become knowns, expect that the plan will change accordingly.
